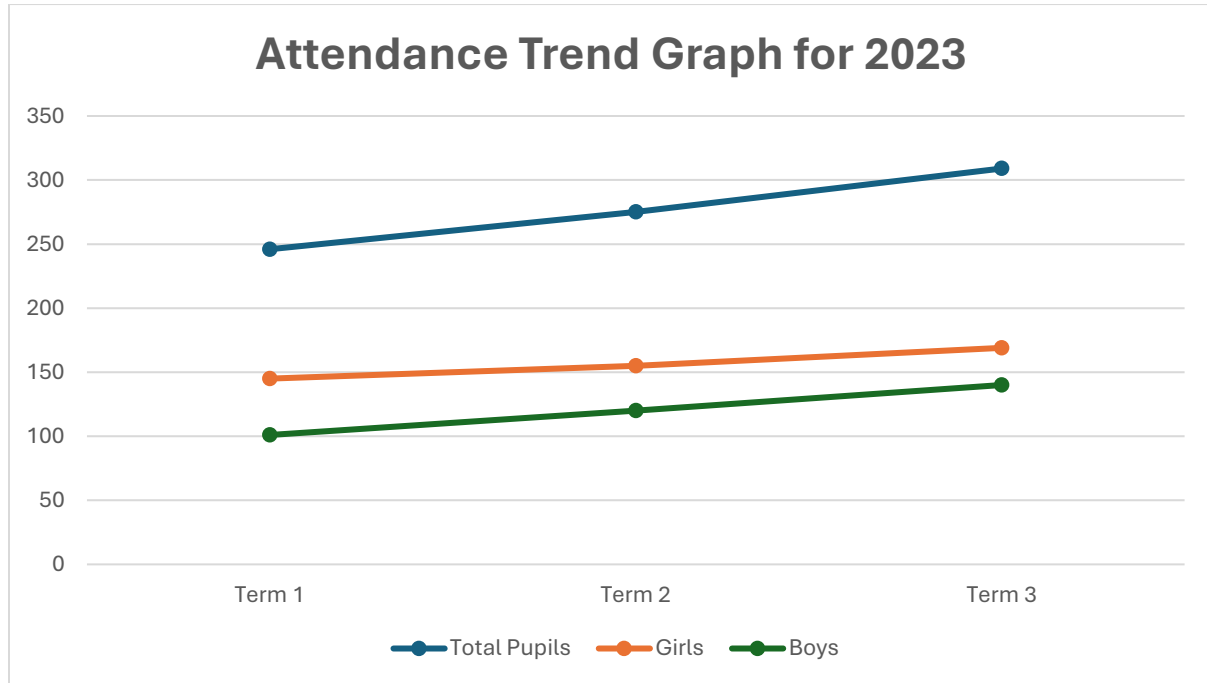
Pupils' Attendance in 2023

Attendance Trend Graph for 2023



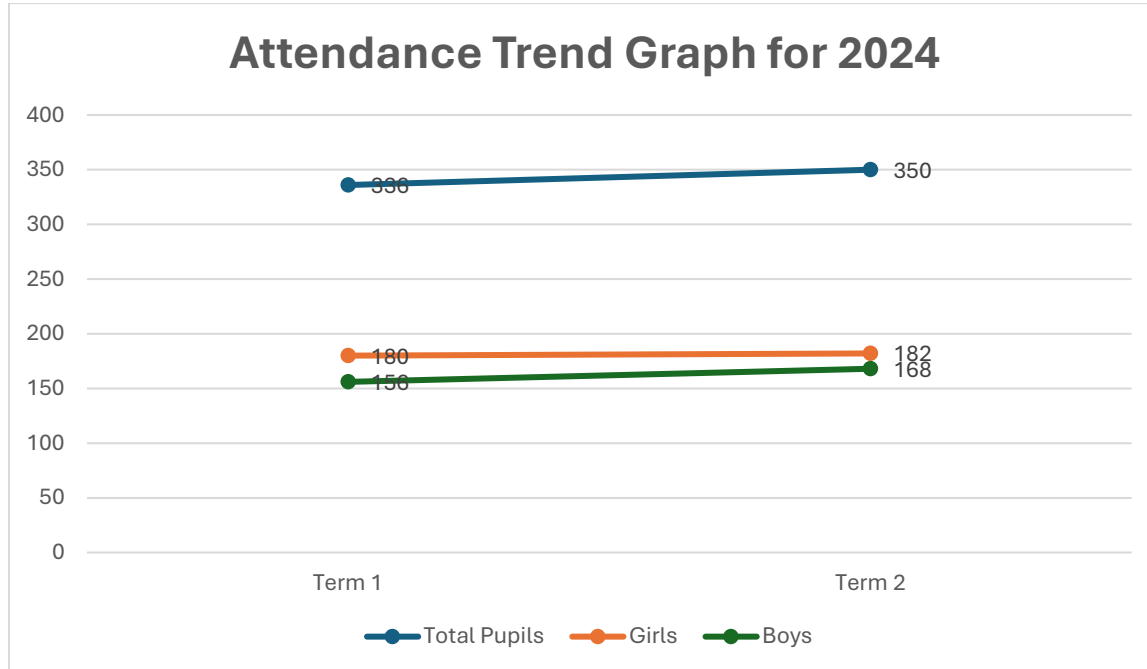
Pupils' Attendance in 2024

 - Girls: 180 (53.6%)
 - Boys: 156 (46.4%)
- **Term 2:**
 - Total pupils: 350
 - Girls: 182 (52.0%)
 - Boys: 168 (48.0%)

Attendance Trend Graph for 2024



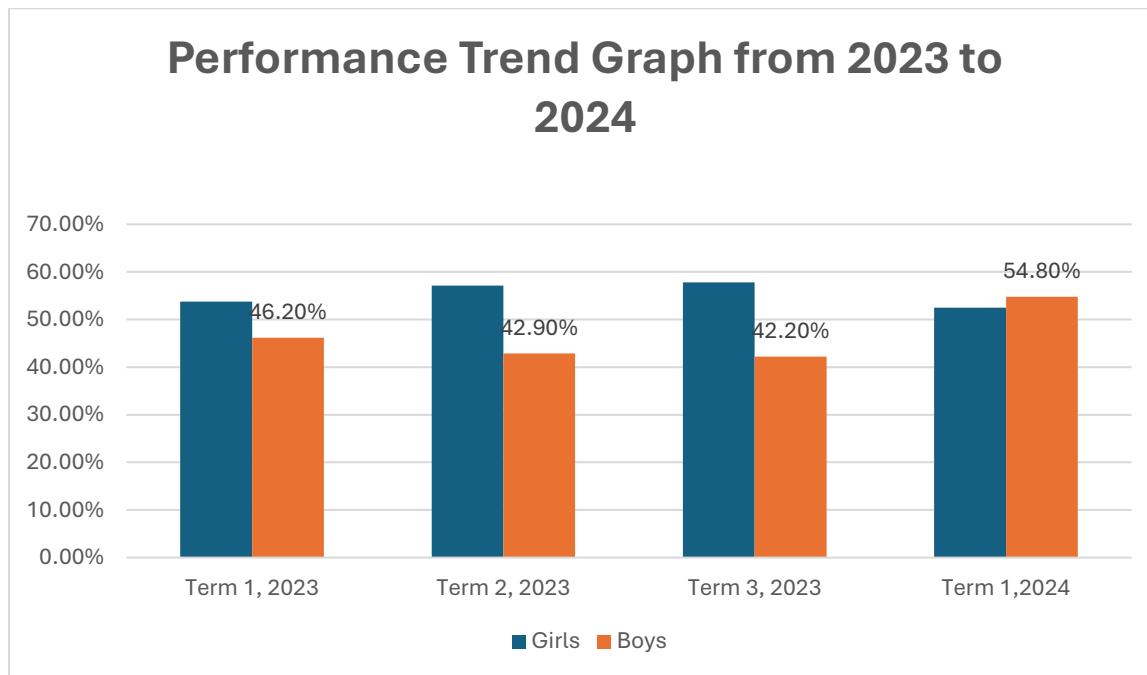
Pupils' Performance from 2023 to 2024

 - Girls: 52.5%
 - Boys: 54.8%
